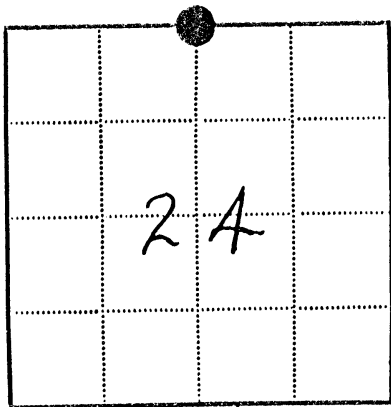
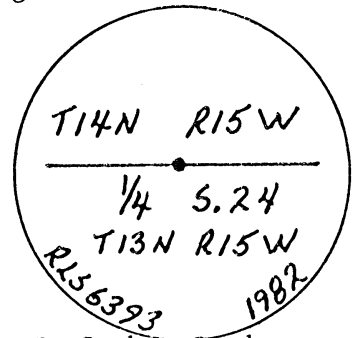

Description of original monument and accessories and subsequent restorations:

Original monument and accessories, as established by Levi Davis Survey (Hocking County) in 1870 are unknown. A plat of the Levi Davis Survey is filed at the Hocking County Recorder's Office, Book A-4, Page 423. Reference is made to Book 1, Hocking County Surveys, filed at the Hocking County Engineer's Office, Page 275. This survey indicates a corner stone and a tile monument were present in 1913.

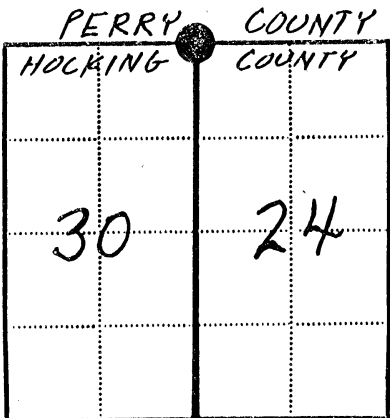
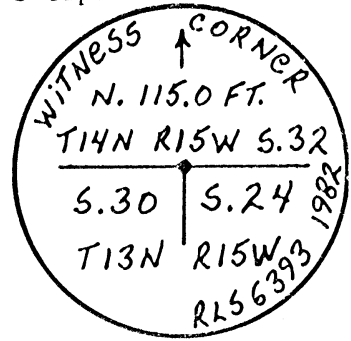
Description of corner evidence found:

Corner point is under water in a strip mine/Beaver Pond, therefore, no corner evidence was recovered. Corner point is supported by U.S. Forest Service acquisition field notes from 1936 and 1937 which call for a stone monument in place. The notes call for tile monuments on the line at 562.32 feet east and 1049.40 feet west. Both tiles were recovered in 1982 at 563.14 and 1045.09 feet respectively.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

A witness corner was set on the Section Line between Sections 30 and 24. It is a 2 1/2" Dia. x 30" concrete filled aluminum pipe with an aluminum cap. The pipe is set 24" into the ground with a few rocks piled around the cap and is 16 feet south and 8 feet east of a high wall on the easterly side of the pond. There is a magnet under the monument's cap. The following bearing trees were established:

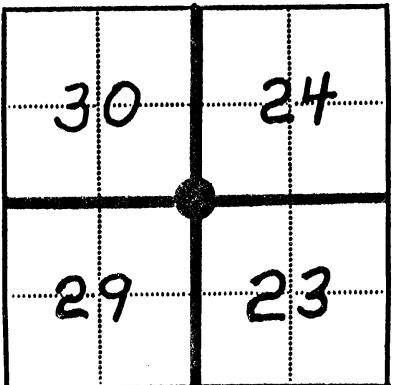
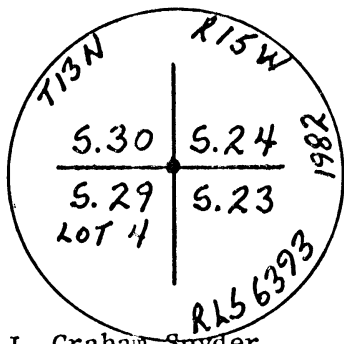
Description of original monument and accessories and subsequent restorations:
The original monument and accessories, as established by the Levi Davis Survey (Hocking County in 1870) are unknown. Plats of the Levi Davis Surveys are filed at the Hocking County Recorder's Office, Book A-4, Pages 422 and 423.

- Subsequent Restorations -
1. Sunday Creek Coal Company, Hocking County. Book 1, Page 57, 1923, Stone Monument, 5 bearing trees, and reference pin 153.6 feet west of monument.
 2. Numerous U.S. Forest Service acquisition and CCC notes referencing the corner from 1936 and 1937. Stone monument with a wood post beside it and bearing trees were called for. All notes are on file at District Ranger's Office, Athens, Ohio.

Description of corner evidence found:
The corner position was found to be buried under stripmined talus slope. Recovered the iron pin set by Sunday Creek Coal Company in 1923. Measured distances to the roads north and west and to the creek east are consistent with the USFS notes from 1936 and 1937.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:
A 2 1/2" dia. x 30" concrete filled aluminum pipe with an aluminum cap stamped as shown below was set for the corner monument. The corner position was determined by using the record distance from the iron pin set by Sunday Creek Coal Company in 1923 and the bearing being consistent with the south line of Section 30.
