


Butins Discontinuance of Town Lots.

Pleas before the Honl John H. Keith President Judge of the 6th Judicial circuit of Ohio, Eli Barker, James Spencer and David Johnson Esqrs Associate Judges of the Court of Common Pleas of Hocking County Ohio began and holden at the court house at Logan in said county on the twenty third day of September A.D. Eighteen hundred and Forty four. Anthony H. Butins ~~Ex parte~~ Petition to vacate Town Lots. Be it remembered that heretofore to wit on the first day of August A.D. 1844 the said Petitioner filed in the clerks office of our said court the following Petition to wit "To the Court of Common Pleas of Hocking County Ohio, your Petitioner Anthony H. Butins of said County represents that he is the sole proprietor of so much of Butins & Fellows addition to the Town of Logan in said county of Hocking as is known described and recorded as in Lots No. 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 17 of said addition and also of the streets and Alleys running through connected with or belonging to said In Lots and which previous to the laying out of the same comprised a part of what was known and laid out original as out Lots No. 42 of said Town of Logan a plat of which addition as originally surveyed and laid off is herewith filed marked a being the original plat and containing the above specified In Lots Streets and Alleys. And your petitioner further represents that he desired title to the said original out Lots No. 42 by deed from the Executors of Thomas Worthington decd. which is herewith filed Marked B3 that the aforesaid Plot and deed have been duly recorded in the records of deeds of said County. Your petitioner therefore prays that so much of said addition of in Lots to the Town of Logan together with the Streets and Alleys thereto belonging as is above specified be vacated and restored to its original character of out Lots No. 42 and as in duty bound will ever pray re By J. Case his atty. The following is the Exhibit marked A and refered to in the Bill to wit "Three In Lots are made of the North part of out Lots No. 41 and 42 on the recorded plat of said Town of Logan. They commence at NE corner of out Lot No 41. and In Lots No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 13, 14, 15, and 16 are made of out Lot No 41 and belong to William Fellows and are of the following description No. 1 is 4 poles wide and 9½ poles long No. 3 and 4 are 3½ poles wide and 9 poles long No. 13 & 14 are 4 poles wide and 9 poles long No. 15 is 4½ poles wide and 9½ poles long No. 16 is 4½ poles wide & 9½ long. No 2. is 5 poles wide and 9½ long
