

Situated in the Township of Marion, County of Hocking and State of Ohio and being a part of section 26 T 15 R 17 and described as follows: Beginning at a point in road, said point being 838.15 ft. north and 591.8 ft. east of the S.E. corner of the S.W. quarter of the S.W. quarter of Sec. 26: thence S 69° 42' W 375.0 ft. to an iron pin, passing an iron pin at 25.0 ft.; thence N 31° 35' W 801.16 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 69° 42' E 375.0 ft. to a point in road, passing an iron pin at 350.0 ft.; thence with road S 31° 35' E 801.16 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 6.767 acres.
