126.31 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set; thence South 44 degrees 19 minutes 03 seconds East a distance of 237.63 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set;

thence South 38 degrees 04 minutes 04 seconds West a distance of 267.38 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set on the North line of the Village of Laurelville Corporation Limits;

thence with the North line of the Village of Laurelville Corporation Limits South 86 degrees 29 minutes 53 seconds East a distance of 306.64 feet to a 1" OD iron pipe found;

thence with the East line of the Village of Laurelville Corporation Limits South 3 degrees 30 minutes 07 seconds West a distance of 355.07 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set;

thence leaving the East line of the Village of Laurelville Corporation Limits and going into the Village of Laurelville North 85 degrees 27 minutes 10

seconds West a distance of 448.62 feet to a 1" OD iron pipe found; thence North 84 degrees 52 minutes 14 seconds West a distance of 146.83 feet to a 1" by 4" iron stake found on the East right of Way of Laurel Street with 6" diameter concrete monument set;
