Range No. 17, of the City of Logan, Ohio, as though the same had nover been platted as a part of said Graceland Addition.

The Court further finds from the evidence that James H. Comstock, who is the sole proprietor not assenting to the vacation, has sustained some damage. The Court further considers in the rendition of a judgment in favor of the said James H. Comstock, that though his wife, Mary June Comstock, did not join as the owner of undivided one-half interest in Lot No. 10, nor appear in court, the damage has been to the whole and not the half.

The Court further finds and has taken judicial notice thereof, that at the time this petition was filed, that the value of the property owned by the petitioners as it stands taxed on the tax list of Hocking County, Ohio, is as follows:
