

Pattisonsville




The above is a plat of a survey of Pattisonsville being a part of one hundred acre Lots No^s 778 and 779 in Township No 13 Range No 16 of the Ohio Company's purchase land: commencing on the West corner of Canal and Market streets where is a stone bearing N 47° 8' 47" ft to a stone on the West corner of First and Market streets and at right angles N 43° W and S 43° E Lat or Fraction No 1 being 57 feet on Canal Street 130 feet back and 190 feet on virgin Alley lot or fraction No 29 being one hundred and sixty feet on first street 130 feet back and 30 feet on virgin Alley lot or fraction No 30 being 44 feet on first street 130 feet back and 175 feet on cherry Alley. The other lots being all 60 ft in front and at right angles back 130 feet. The streets being 60 feet in width and the alleys 20 feet except Canal Street which is 70 feet in width Surveyed Nov 8th 1839
