E 70.00 feet to an iron pin; thence S.67°21'.E 117.33 feet to an iron pin; thence S.58°09'.E 170.00 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 31° 51'. W 80.62 feet to an iron pin; thence S.2° 51'. W 393.30 feet to an iron pin; thence S.87°09'E 13.00 feet to an iron pin; thence S.2°51'.W 236.95 feet to an iron pin; thence N.75° 47'.W 309.37 feet to an iron pin at the Southeast corner of Lot No. 40 of the Washington Bowers 2nd.
